Many well wishers of our college have donated books. The total number of books donated during the current year is 81 worth Rs. 8, 410. The college library has a spacious Reading room, Reference section, Journal section, Newspaper section, U.G.C. Books section, Book Bank section, Periodical section with book issue counter, Paper clipping section, Internet browsing service, overnight service, reprographic service, and new edition display section, question bank section, employment advertisement display section. The college is subscribing 85 periodicals and 4 journals and 10 Newspapers. Allocation of funds for the purchase of new books for all departments is done on an annual basis. Reference books, Text books and Periodicals are made available to students during the academic year. As many as 24,182 students availed books from the library in the academic year under review.

COLLEGE FACULTY

The Teaching faculty consists of faculty for Arts, Commerce, Management, Language and Education; teaching B.A., B.Com., B.B.M., M.Com. and B.Ed Courses. There are 12 full time permanent lecturers drawing UGC scale. Among them two have secured doctorate degree and three have submitted their thesis, and are awaiting for the award of the Ph.D degree. Two staff members are in the process of submission of their thesis. Apart from this six permanent faculty members drawing UGC scale have been deputed to other institutions for want of required workload in the degree section as per the Government policy. In addition, there are 15 full time and 8 part-time Management paid faculty, one with D.Lit. and another with M. Phil degree. Out of this 9 faculties are serving in the B. Ed section and 4 faculties are serving in the M.Com section.

STUDENT STRENGTH

The total number of students in B.A., B.Com and B.B.M. is 472. There are 289 boys and 183 girls in the general degree section. Out of which 10 students are from other States.

Among the new admission 76 per cent belong to SC/ST/OBC/BT group and 68 per cent students are below the poverty line.

The total number of students in M.Com is 47. There are 9 boys and 38 girls in the post-graduate commerce section. Out of this 22 students belong to SC/ST/OBC group and 25 students are from poor economic background. 20 students hail from urban area and 27 from rural. The total number of students in B.Ed. Course is 61 out of which 87 per cent students belong to SC/ST/OBC group and 13 per cent students are from poor economic background. There are 6 boys and 55 girls in B.Ed section.

Degree courses in arts and Commerce i.e., B.A and B.Com are under grant – in Aid by the Govt of Karnataka. However degree programme in Business Management (B.B.M.), Post Graduation course in Commerce (M.Com) and Bachelor degree in Education (B.Ed.) are the self-financed courses.

The Management conducts free medical camp every Sunday for the benefit of poor patients of the locality. Amount spent for the year 2011-12 is Rs.24,310. Regular follow up of the patients is done to see that the medical camp functions effectively.

d) GOOD CONDUCT PRIZES

The right type of education should help the individual to grow to his fullest stature and at the same time accelerate the progress of society. To motivate our students to develop good character and discipline, good conduct scholarships are awarded to a boy and a girl student of each class every year.

e) DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARY:

Every department is equipped with a departmental library. Books are lent out to students on a first come serve basis.

f) FACILITIES PROVIDED TO THE PUBLIC

The hall is made available to the public for classes of professional, religious, cultural, sports and of a political nature.

g) INSTITUTION OF A FUND IN MEMORY OF THE FOUNDER CORRESPONDENT OF THE COLLEGE

Students are availing the scholarship installed in the name of the founder correspondent who rendered selfless service to the institution in its infant stage.

h) DONATION TOWARDS THE GOKARNANATHA TEMPLE FOR PROVIDING FREE FOOD TO THE DEVOTEES

The Management of the college contributes generously towards the free-mid-day meals which is organised in the temple premises. The teachers contribute during the Narayana Guru Jayanthi and Shivarathri festival to this cause. Mrs.Sabiha Tasneem annually contributes Rs.4000/- towards the distribution of food for the above cause.

i) INNOVATIVE TEACHING TECHNIQUES, SEMINARS, GUEST LECTURES

The various subject lecturers conduct seminars for bringing out the creativity among the students and to enable them to overcome stage fear.
