

Courses of Study:

The College offers the following courses leading to the award of Bachelor's Degree in Arts and Commerce by the Mangalore University.

Choice Based Credit System

As per the directions of University Grants Commission, Mangalore University has introduced the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS, Semester Scheme) in its undergraduate programme to be on par with the global standards. Under this scheme, each course in a programme shall carry certain number of credits, which normally represent the weightage of a course and are a function of teaching, learning and evaluation strategies such as number of contact hours, the course content, teaching methodology, learning expectations, etc. In the proposed programmes, in general, 2 hours of instructions per week in a semester is assigned one credit. In terms of evaluation, one credit is equivalent to 50 marks in a semester. On these basis, a three year degree programme will have a maximum of 100 - 104 credits. Each programme of study will have "Core courses", "Electives" (of Group II & Group III), "Foundation" courses and "Extra and co-curricular activities". The Core courses will consist compulsory/optional courses which are compulsorily studied by a student in all six semesters whereas Elective and Foundation courses are opted in I to IV Semesters.

ELIGIBILITY: A candidate, who has passed the Two Year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Board of Pre-University Education in Karnataka or any other Examination considered as equivalent there to, is eligible for admission to the Degree Course.

HOW TO APPLY: The application Forms should be filled in complete with regard to all the information asked for in the candidate's own handwriting. Application forms should be registered at the college office paying the prescribed fee within 10 days of publication of II PUC results.

After Registration the candidate should appear for personal interview along with his/her parent/guardian. Candidates while appearing for the interview should bring the following certificates in original: 1. PUC certificate/Marks Card, 2. Transfer Certificate issued by the institution last attended, 3. Conduct Certificate from the institution last attended. 4. Migration/ Eligibility Certificate wherever required and a passport size photograph for the identity card.

If selected intimation will be sent to the candidates to join. They should pay the prescribed fees immediately and such fees will not be refunded under any circumstances.

PAYMENT OF FEES:

Tuition fees for the year is payable in four instalments not later than the day marked in the calender. If a student fails to pay the fees by the date fixed for payments in the Calender, the student will have to pay a fine of Re. 1/-per day. If the fees is not paid within 15 days, the students name will be struck off from the rolls.

General Regulations

- (a) The working day is divided into two sessions. The morning session extends from 9.45 a.m. to 12.45 p.m., 1.45 p.m. To 3.45 p.m. Tutorial / Remedial coaching & afternoon session from 3.45 p.m. to 4.45 p.m.
 - (b) At the first warning bell for class, given 5 minutes before the hour, students enter class and occupy their places. At the second bell, the Lecturers enter classes and the students stand in silence to receive them.
- 2. Late comers can enter the class only if permitted by the lecturer.
- 3. Irregularity in attendance, insubordination, habitual inattention, neglect of work, obscenity in word or act are punishable by permanent or temporary Dismissal.
- Every student should possess an Identity Card which should be produced when asked for, especially in dealing with the Office and Library.
- Students are warned that they should get a minimum of 75 percent of attendance for each subject, failing which they will be ineligible to appear for the University Examination.
