College Day Report 2022-23

Esteemed dignitaries on the dias, member of College governing Council invitees , dear colleagues and my dear students I extend a warm and cordial welcome to all who are present here. I consider it as a great privilege to present before you a brief report of our academic performance and achievements of the students during academic year 2021-2022.

Shree Gokarnanatheshwara College of Education is of 2 units i.e 100 students strength and 67 students were enrolled during this academic year for I Semester. There are 5 full time,3 part time teaching staff and 3 non teaching staff who are rendering their dedicated service for the progress of our institution.

The academic calendar for the year 2021-2022 started on April 6 th 2022. The college started with an orientation programme to welcome the freshers to the college followed by freshers day (Parichay) on May 10th.

As per the B.Ed scheduled syllabus the I Semester students were briefed with the syllabus and the programme of events followed as per the prescribed by the Mangalore University syllabus like Micro Teaching , Psycho Social Tools, ICT Basic Competencies and Language Across the curriculum followed by the General Subjects.

The newly attended batch enjoyed each and every programme both academics and non academics such that they get acquainted to the teaching field which they would acquire in their new future.

The III Semester students had an diversion from main stream of teaching learning process towards and also imbibing the qualities and skills both

curricular and extra curricular for this III Semester along with general subjects had workshops on Drama and Art conducted under the mentorship of Mr.Jagan Powar Director of Ranga Shikshana Karyagara.

Student council was inaugurated on 20th May and all the council members had pledged their oath of responsibilities and on the same day soil conservational day was celebrated and our students enthusiastically participated in it and World environmental day was celebrated on June 5th.

In order to build a sound mind and sound body Yoga plays a significant role and hence to enhance this the students had yoga class twice in a week which was initiated by our Physical Director and international yoga day was celebrated on June 21st and our students enthusiastically took part in it.

As a part of inclusive education our students visited Mangala Jyothi Integrated School located in Vamanjoor and spent a day with the students there and the school briefed about the different programs they undertake.

Different cultural competition was held for the students in association with Drama And Arts subject which was initiated by Mrs. Suchithra Shetty.

On the occasion of Narayan Guru Jayanti and 75 Independence day celebration (Azadi ka Amrit Mahostav) different competitions held at our college and students actively participated and bagged the prizes.

On the occasion of the 75th Independence Day Celebration a Cultural Programme was held and our students also had a opportunity to visit Sandesha College of Fine Arts and they also gave a radio program.

As per the calendar of events the first and second semester last working day was 12th August. Followed by revision holiday and the students wrote their Mangalore University semester exam from 22nd September 2022 to 6th September 2022.

The results of the semester exam was announced on 13 th December and The college has secured 100% results in the III semester and 99% result in the I semester for the academic year 2021-2022.

Moving on to the present semesters the II and IV semester commenced on 18th September 2022.
