General Regulations and Code of Conduct

1. Classes will be held between 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m and 1.30 p.m to 4.30 p.m on Mondays to Fridays and between 9.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on Saturdays.

At the first warning bell for class, given 5 minutes before the hour, students enter class and occupy their places. At the second bell, the Lecturers enter classes and the students stand in silence to receive them. At once all pray in silence to obtain God's light and help in the work before them.

2. Late comers can enter the class only if permitted by the Lecturer. They may be marked present at the end of the hour only if there was sufficient reason for being late. Those who depend on public conveyance to come to the college should leave their homes early enough to avoid peak hours and be at the college well in time.
3. During class the lecturers permission is needed to move away from once place or to leave the room.

4. Irregularity in attendance, insubordination, discourtesy to staff members, habitual inattention and late coming, neglect of work, obscenity in word or act are punishable by permanent or temporary dismissal. Minor offences are punishable by a fine or loss of attendance.
5. Every student should possess Identity Card which should be produced when asked for, especially in dealing with the Office and Library.
6. Punctual and regular attendance is essential for the formation of character and is therefore insisted upon. Leave of absence from college should be obtained from the concerned authority. Unforeseen absence must be justified on return before entering class with a note of excuse from the parent or guardian. A medical certificate should be furnished especially when a student is absent for a long time due to illness. **A medical certificate however does not entitle a student for attendance.** The names of students who are absent continuously for 2 weeks without any notice will be struck off from the register.
Those who are deputed officially by the college to participate in academic, cultural or sports activities should hand over to the academic advisors a note of deputation signed by the concerned teacher.
Serious notice will be taken of absence without leave from the college examinations, at the reopening of classes after the holidays. In the case of illness, the production of medical certificate shall be required.
7. The college does not hold itself responsible for conduct of its students outside its premises. Injustice to itself however, it takes cognizance of any serious misconduct of its student committed outside its precincts and should any serious charge be fairly substantiated, the guilty shall be punished according to the gravity of the offence.
8. The applications of the student whose progress, based on the performance in the terminal examinations, if not satisfactory will not be recommended to the university for the annual examination.
9. Every student must salute members of the staff on the occasion of his first meeting for the day.
10. Books, magazines, newspapers etc, not approved by the principal, are not allowed to be brought to the college.
11. Those who come with motor cycle, scooter, mopeds should have valid driving licence and insurance. To avoid noise pollution and disturbance the vehicle should have sufficient silencers. Students are allowed to park their vehicle only in the place allotted to them. However four wheelers are not allowed.
12. We do not wish to see students consuming alcohol or using tobacco, drugs in any form in the college premises. If they do so they will be summarily dismissed
13. Books, umbrellas etc should have a name or mark by which the owner can be easily known. All stray or unclaimed property should be brought to the

notice of the Principal.

14. Students are required to live either with their parents, relatives or guardians or in hostel or lodging house. Residing hotels is not permitted. Outstation students living in rented house/flats should invariably inform the principal details of place of residence.
15. Students must not join any club or society or make any engagement that may inter fear with their studies without the principals permission. They are not allowed to play in any team against the college.
16. Students are not allowed to take part in any political agitation directed against the authority of government. They are also forbidden to engage prominently in any public movement without permission from the principal. They are further required to observe all the disciplinary regulations which the management may frame from time to time.
17. Letters officially addressed to the principal should enclose reply postage. Only officially letters will be handed over to the students. Private letters are redirected to the home or hostel address.
18. Attendance at classes and examinations, progress as well as the conduct of the student will be taken into consideration while recommending students for merit certificates, Concessions, Scholarships, higher studies, jobs as well as for representing college in extra mural activities.
19. Students are not authorise to collect donations from the public or from their fellow students for any of the college activity without the permission for the principal. Educational tours/picnics are to be organised with prior permission of the Principal. For all such programmes Written permission of the parents is required.
20. Students are not permitted to celebrate any religious festivals within the college campus without the prior permission of the Principal.
21. Willful damage to the property of college books, furniture, water, gas and electrical installation etc. will be viewed seriously. In case of damage to the college property, the cost of repair and any other charge will be collected from the student. But if the person who are responsible for damage are not identified, the cost of repairs etc may be collected equally from all the student of the college. The decisions of principal is final in all these matters.
22. If on occasions the student s have free hour they should to retire to the reading room or students common room In either place they should engage themselves in serious work such as reading or writing.
24. All extra curricular activities ceased at 5.30 p. m. Students have to vacate the college campus by 5.30 p.m. unless a teacher is present with them.

Students Counselling Cell : Students Counseling aims at helping the students not only with their academic difficulties but also with their personal and emotional problems. Mr. Udaya Kumar B. Principal is a Counselor in charge of Counseling Cell. Students and parents may always approach him for guidance and help in their academic, personal and emotional problems.

Rules Regarding Library :

1. The Library is subdivided into (i) Reference Library and (ii) Lending Library.
2. The Library will be under the supervision of a Lecturer of the College appointed by the Principal.
3. The Library is open to all students and members of the staff of the College.
4. The Library will open every working day from 9.30 am. to 4.30 pm. and it will be closed on Sundays and all other recognised holidays.
5. Books from the reference section will not be allowed to be taken out of the Library except with the written authorisation of the subject Lecturers concerned. They can be consulted in the Library room on all days during which the Library remains open. During the time of teaching practice, special arrangements will be made for more liberal use of Library books.
6. Strict silence must be observed in the Library.
7. The issue of books from the lending section is governed by the following rules :-
 - (i) Students are permitted to take out one book at a time from the Library.
 - (ii) Books cannot be sub-lent.
 - (iii) The almirahs will be kept open from 2 pm. to 4 pm. when students may select from the shelves the books they require and present them to the Librarian with the prescribed loan form duly filled in. The Librarian will then issue the books to the applicant who will surrender his library ticket.
 - (iv) Books may be returned to the Librarian between 11 am. to 12 noon and 1.15 pm. to 4.30 pm. No other books, note books or files except loose sheets of paper may be brought into the Library.

When a book is returned the student will get back his ticket. He will then satisfy himself that the Librarian fills up the date of return on his application for loan and files it with other slips relating to returned books.

- (v) Books which are difficult to get may be applied for, in advance. Books which do not have to be kept overnight may be consulted in the Library. Tables are specially set apart for the purpose. The books should, after consultation be handed over to the Librarian for

replacement. Students should not replace the books in the shelves.

- (vi) All markings, underlining, etc., of books are punishable with fine or with replacement or both.
- (vii) The student must satisfy himself as to whether the book issued to him is in sound condition and if it is not, bring the matter to the notice of the Librarian. For all damages to books noticed at the time of their return to the Library, the borrower will be held responsible and he will have to pay the cost of replacement.
- (viii) Periodicals, Reference books etc., which may be difficult to replace and such other works as may from time to time be regarded as unsuitable for lending will not be lent out.
- (ix) No Books shall be kept for more than seven days by a borrower. If the due date falls on a holiday, the next working day after the holiday will be considered as the due date.
- (x) A book may be re-issued to a student at his request if there is no demand for it from any other student.
- (xi) The Principal may recall any book lent to a student, at any time.
- (xii) If a book is not returned when due or called for fine of five paise per day of default will be levied.
- (xiii) A student against whom any fine or other charge is outstanding, will not be permitted to take books from the Library till he has paid up in full.
- (xiv) If a book is lost by a borrower, he must at once report the loss to the Principal.
- (xv) If a copy of the lost book is available in the market the missing books should be replaced by a new copy of it, or its market price at the time with postal charges for getting the book should be paid.

Reference Section :

- (i) Readers shall not write upon, damage or make any mark upon any book, manuscript or map belonging to the Library.
- (ii) Before leaving, the readers must return to the Librarian any book, manuscript or map they have taken for consultation.

Hostel :

There is a hostel facility for both men & women students. It is obligatory on the part of the students who are not resident in Mangalore with their parents or guardians to stay in the Hostel.

TO PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

Parents and guardians are requested to cooperate with the college authorities by enforcing discipline and regularity at home. In order that lessons may be duly prepared, students should be devoted to study at home. If parents do not insist on regular attendance and home study, the results are sure to be disappointing to them.

Absence from class should be justified by a leave note from the student signed by parent/guardian. A leave note for a long absence due to illness supported by a medical certificate. A medical certificate does not entitle a student for attendance.

Absence from college, examinations will be considered seriously. Absence, even for one subject should be justified by a written note. A medical note is needed in case of illness. Re examinations cannot be considered as a matter of right. In case of illness during the examinations, parents are expected to inform the Principal immediately.

Some parents express their surprise at the end of the year, at the unsatisfactory attendance and progress of their children inspite of our sending reports to them. Progress reports of students will be issued after the examinations. Some students failed to hand over their progress reports to their parents/guardians. You are requested to come over to the college office and check in case the reports are not received by you within reasonable time.

You are asked to meet the academic advisor or other lecturers if unsatisfactory progress or poor attendance is brought to your notice. The minimum of 75% attendance is required to complete the course without which a student is not eligible to take final examination. They will not be readmitted to the college.

We expect parents to participate in parents meetings and other activities of the college like founders day, sports day, prize distribution day, college day etc.

Attendance at Parent Teacher meeting is obligatory. In case you are not able to attend for a just reason, a written note should be sent to the principal.

Parents are specially asked not to allow their children to use a motorized vehicle without a valid licence and insurance.

Use of mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the college premises. So parents are specially asked not to allow their children to bring cell phone to the college.

Students are prohibited from wearing indecent dresses, fancy ornaments (Boys), long hairs (boys). Parents kindly advice your children in this respect.

ಹೆತ್ತವರು ಮತ್ತು ಪಾಲಕರು ತಮ್ಮ ಮಕ್ಕಳಲ್ಲಿ ಹಾಗೂ ಪಾಲಿತರಲ್ಲಿ ನಿಯಮ ಪಾಲನೆ ಹಾಗೂ ಶಿಸ್ತಿಗೆ ಗಮನವೀಯುವುದರ ಮೂಲಕ ಅಧ್ಯಾಪಕರೊಡನೆ ಸಹಕರಿಸಬೇಕಾಗಿ ವಿನಂತಿ. ಮನೆಯಲ್ಲಿಯೇ ನಿಯಮ ಬದ್ಧ ಅಧ್ಯಯನವು ಕಾಲೇಜಿನ ಅಧ್ಯಯನಕ್ಕೆ ಬಹಳ ಸಹಕಾರಿಯಾಗಬಲ್ಲದು. ಪಾಲಕರು ಮನೆಯಲ್ಲಿನ ಅಧ್ಯಯನ ಹಾಗೂ ಹಾಜರಿಯ ಬಗ್ಗೆ ಗಮನಹರಿಸದಿದ್ದರೆ ಪರಿಣಾಮ ಬಹಳ ನಿರಾಶಾದಾಯಕವಾಗಬಹುದು. ತಮ್ಮ ಪಾಠಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ಬರುವ ಯಾವುದೇ ಸಂದೇಹಗಳನ್ನು ತಮ್ಮ ಅಧ್ಯಾಪಕರ ಸಹಾಯವನ್ನು ಪಡೆದು ಪರಿಹರಿಸಿಕೊಳ್ಳಬಹುದು. ಅಧ್ಯಾಪಕರು ನಡೆಸುವ ವಿಶೇಷ ತರಗತಿಗಳಿಗೆ ತಮ್ಮ ಮಕ್ಕಳು ಹಾಜರಾಗುವಂತೆ ಹೆತ್ತವರು ತಿಳಿಹೇಳಬೇಕು.

ಯಾವುದೇ ತರಗತಿಗೆ ಗೈರುಹಾಜರಾದಲ್ಲಿ ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳು ಈ ಕ್ವಾಂಟರನಲ್ಲಿ ನಿಗದಿತ ನಮೂನೆಯಲ್ಲಿ ಹೆತ್ತವರಿಂದ ಸಹಿ ಮಾಡಲ್ಪಟ್ಟ ರಜಾ ಅರ್ಜಿಯನ್ನು ತರಗತಿಯ ಶೈಕ್ಷಣಿಕ ಸಲಹೆಗಾರರು/ಪ್ರಾಂಶುಪಾಲರಿಗೆ ಒಪ್ಪಿಸಿ ಅನುಮತಿಯನ್ನು ಪಡೆದುಕೊಳ್ಳತಕ್ಕದ್ದು. ಮೂರು ದಿವಸಗಳಿಗಿಂತ ಹೆಚ್ಚು ದಿವಸಗಳ ರಜೆಗೆ ಮುಂಚಿತವಾಗಿ ಪ್ರಾಂಶುಪಾಲರಿಂದ ಅನುಮತಿಯನ್ನು ಪಡೆಯತಕ್ಕದ್ದು. ಆರೋಗ್ಯದ ಕಾರಣದಿಂದ ರಜೆಯಾದ ಸಂದರ್ಭದಲ್ಲಿ ವೈದ್ಯರಿಂದ ಪರೀಕ್ಷಾ ಪತ್ರ ಸಲ್ಲಿಸತಕ್ಕದ್ದು. ಅದಾಗ್ಯೂ ವೈದ್ಯರ ಪ್ರಮಾಣ ಪತ್ರದಿಂದಾಗಿ ಹಾಜರಿದೊರೆಯಲಾರದು.
