1. Curricular Aspects

Ours is a constituent college under Mangalore University. Consequently, there is no scope for the college to design the curriculum. Dr.Ashalatha S Suvarna and Dr.Jayaprakash are part of the curriculum designing task undertaken by the university and they have immensely contributed in their own way either as a faculty member, Member of BOS and BOE committee. Their valuable inputs in curriculum designing and planning have an added advantage to the college in guiding and monitoring the faculties.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been established in the college to ensure the implementation of quality programmes and activities. All the activities undertaken in the college are ably guided by Mr. Yatheen, Faculty of Commerce, and Dr. Jayaprakash, Physical Education Director as NAAC and IQAC Co-Ordinator's respectively under the mentorship of Principal of the college.
